SALO HABITAT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

In 2017, the Town of Ulysses received a grant to purchase about 32 acres of property, formerly owned by Habitat for Humanity, off of Salo Drive.

In September of 2018, the Town Board voted to **prohibit hunting** on the property for the 2018 season.

The Town Board also established an advisory committee charged with recommending "guidelines for the use, promotion, and maintenance of The Habitat including but not limited to:

- Rules, amenities and safety recommendations to protect The Habitat, visitors, and adjacent neighborhoods
- Appropriate access points to The Habitat that do not intrude on neighboring properties
- Signage to guide The Habitat visitors to and through the area, including where to park
- Affordable plans for maintaining The Habitat
- Recruiting and coordinating volunteer workers
- Strategies to inform the public about The Habitat and its appropriate use and guidelines
- A plan for soliciting periodic feedback from users & neighbors to evaluate The Habitat"
